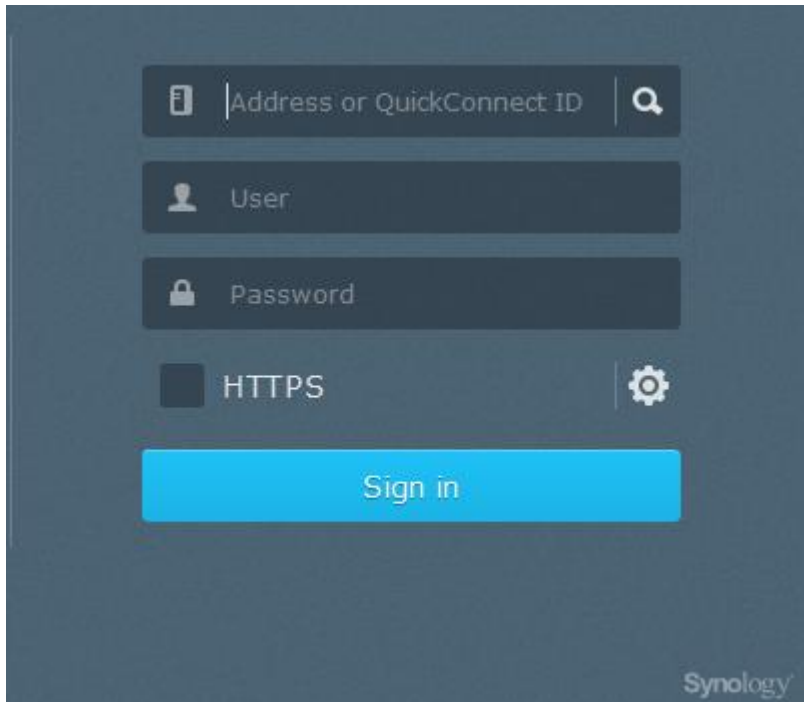


Mobile Setup

Please download DS Cam from the Apple Store ([DS Cam For Apple](#)) if you have an Apple device, or from the Play Store ([DS Cam For Android](#)) if you have an Android device.

1. Once the app has been downloaded, type in either the “QuickConnect ID” or the “IP Address” given to you by IT.
2. Type in the username and password given to you by IT.




After logging in using the “DS Cam” app, you will be presented with the cameras that have been setup. Click on the camera windows to view them in full-screen.

Surveillance Desktop App

Please download the surveillance app (Surveillance App) from the Synology website

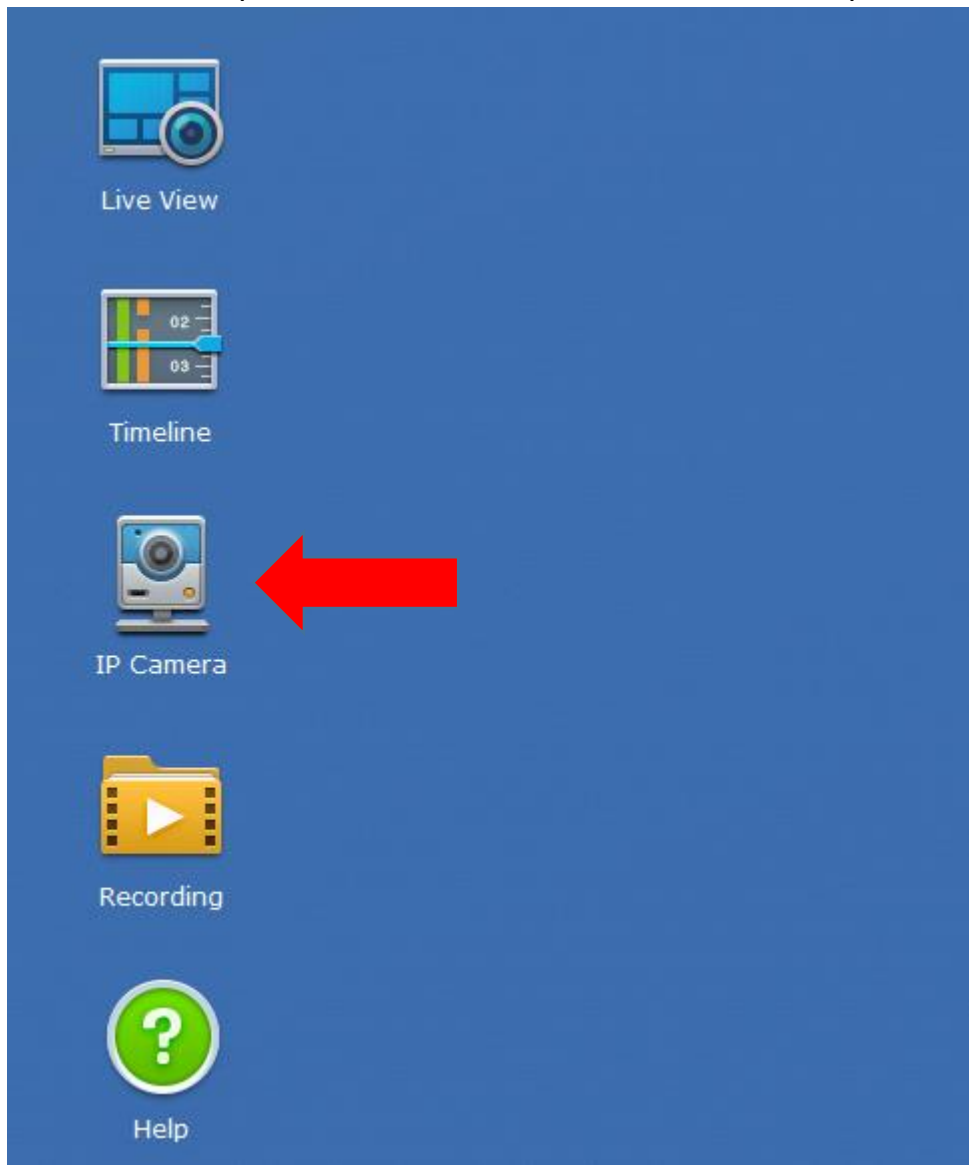
Once the app has been downloaded, type in either the “QuickConnect ID” or the “IP Address” given to you by IT.

2. Double-click\tp on the “IP Camera” icon on the desktop.

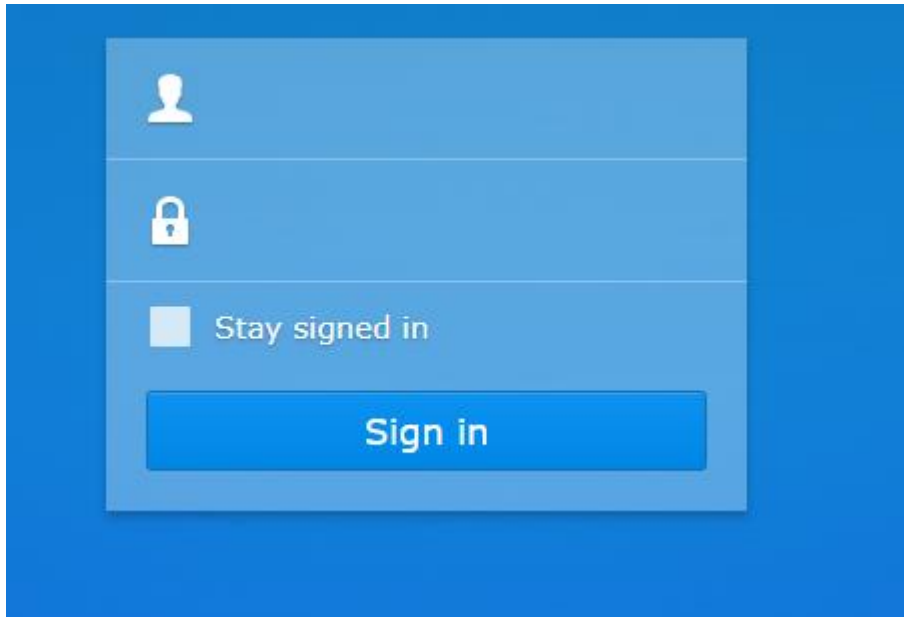


Once the “IP Camera” app opens, you’ll be able to view all the cameras. Double-click on the camera windows to view them in full-screen.

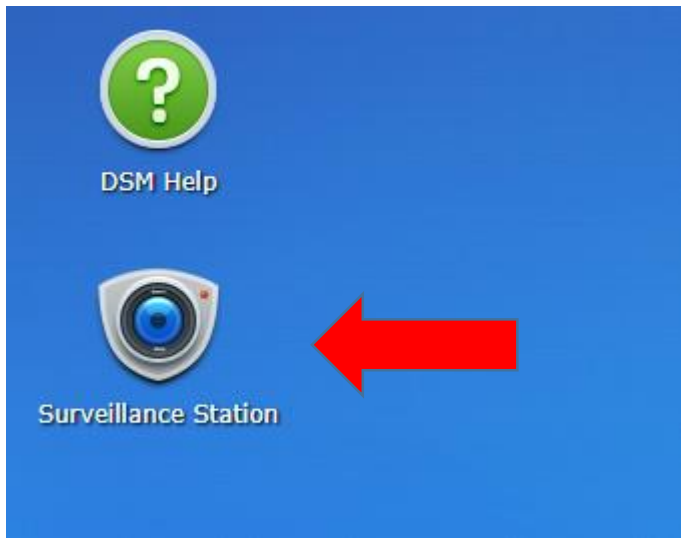
Web Access

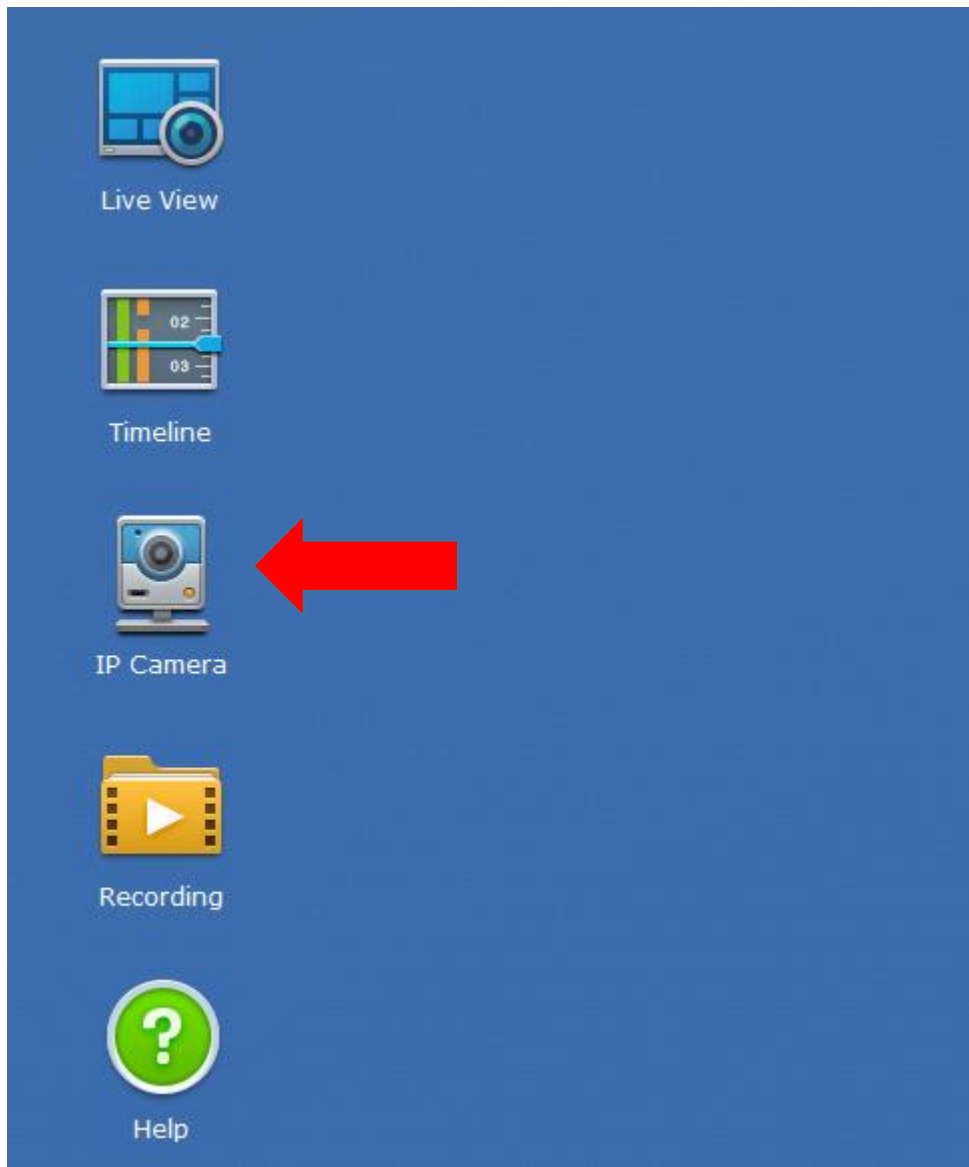
1. Once on the webpage, type in the username and password given to you by IT.
